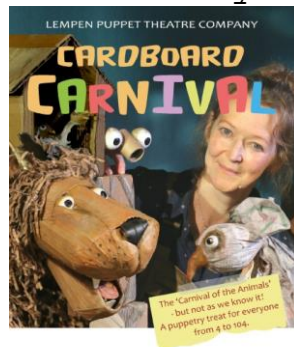


## Class 1 Week by week
