What a surprise we had after the weekend to find our beanstalks have really got going. The tallest one is now over 40cm high!

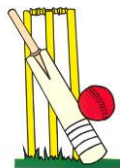
We have been keeping a diary over the weeks and will be making a chart next week to show how much they have grown.
