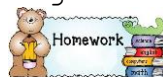

and back.

Spending pocket money - work out which coins to use
to pay.



English/Topic

Noticing signs in the shops, café or on the roads -
have a go to read.

Learn to sing or say the alphabet - write the capital

letters.

Read/listen to stories and act them out - make up stories of your own too!
