Important notice regarding School lunch and Breakfast club.

Across the County, schools have recently had a review of their school lunch prices.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils are still entitled to a free school lunch, however there is a charge for pupils in KS2 (Y3/4/5/6). The average charge for a school lunch across North Yorkshire is £2.25.

Our school meal prices have remained the same (£2.10) since 2010 and provide our children with a healthy, balanced, freshly cooked meal. Charges are based on the cost of the meal and we make every effort to stick to the budget to keep prices as low as possible for parents.

Due to increases in food prices and staffing costs and to bring charges in-line with the rest of the County, Governors have agreed that prices for our chargeable school meals will need to go up from September.

For the same reasons, we also need to make a small increase to charges in Breakfast Club provision. We have, however, negotiated for After School Club charges to remain the same.

Effective from the beginning of September 2018, our charges for school lunches and Breakfast and After School Club will be as follows:

KS2 School Meal: £2.50

Breakfast Club : £2.50

After School Club : £6.00

We hope you agree that this still provides very good value for money.

With this in mind we ask that your ParentPay account is kept up to date monthly and the balance is paid at the end of each month. Thank you.

We have been lucky enough to secure some time from volunteers at Nestle. The company allocate employees time to work for charitable organisations. I'm sure you will agree, they have made a lovely job at refreshing Class 2's outdoor space. We have new furniture arriving so children will also have this space for after half term and into next year. We have sent a couple of thank you letters, written by pupils in class 2 which have been very gratefully received.
