Special notices

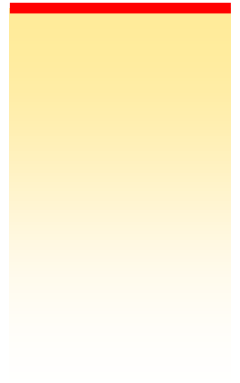
