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

## SWIMMING

## Lunches

As you may know, we provide a **FREE** school lunch for our Reception, Y1 and Y2 pupils. The meals are all prepared freshly on the premises daily and Rachael does an amazing job at letting the children try a variety of healthy and nutritional foods. Choices of water or milk are available as part of their lunch. If your child would like to stay for a school lunch on any day of the week or you need to see a school menu, please let your child's class teacher know. The cost for lunches for other children will remain at £10.50 per week (£2.10 per day) for Y3-Y6 children.
