RWM 7 pupils were in KS2, 3 of which had joined school whilst in Y5. One pupil was absent for the Maths test. All pupils in calculation were classified as mobile.

- In 2015, the following achieved at least 2 levels progress or more based on KS1 data:
 - 100% Reading (85.7% achieved 3 levels progress)
 - 100% Writing (28.6% achieved 3 levels progress)
 - 85.7% Maths (14.3% achieved 3 levels progress)
- ✓ Priorities for KS2 remain closing the attainment gap for all pupils with focus on Maths.
- ✓ Arrangements for 2016: New SATs test for Reading, SPaG and Maths at KS1 and KS2. Writing will continue to use Teacher Assessments which will be moderated. All children will be assessed against their END OF YEAR EXPECTATIONS and KS2 pupils will also receive a scaled score for SATs.
